

TREASURY OF MEMORY – 2010

The Memorial Fund was a fund/committee formed whereby individuals contributed gifts or gifts of money as living memorials or in memory of loved ones.

When the church was established in 1912, many families contributed appointments "in memory" of loved ones such as the beautiful opalescent stained glass windows, baptismal font, metal ware, statues, sewer repair, etc. Throughout the years many more gifts were donated. This information was well documented for some 36 years by Sarah Warner (a Trinity church charter member 1895-1984) until 1983 when she then appointed me as Treasurer.

Since the church was well furnished by 1954, a savings account was established for future memorial gifts of money. It was from these ongoing contributions that the Memorial Fund strived to purchase items of "lasting value and quality". Through the later years, monies were used towards the front barrier-free entrance, hymnals, Book of Gospels, Eucharist lectern, vestments, pulpit and lectern falls, linens, marriage candelabra and kitchen remodeling to name a few.

The fund will now be known as Trinity Treasury of Memories Foundation, Inc.
