## **Reverend Aaron Jay Evans**

The Vestry is pleased to announce Reverend Aaron Jay Evans has accepted our call as Trinity's Part Time Rector under Contract. This call is for four months and may be reviewed on an annual basis. Fr. Aaron will begin work on September 1, and his first preaching day will be Sunday September 12, 2010. This is also our Annual Lamb Roast Sunday, and the Vestry plans a celebration for his first day. His Part Time position is described as 2 working days, one of which is Sunday. Fr. Aaron lives in the Muskegon area where his wife, Rachael, is the Rector at St. Gregory's and also serves as a priest for a Lutheran church.

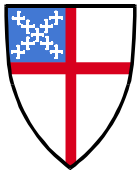
