Grand Ledge and Mid-Michigan

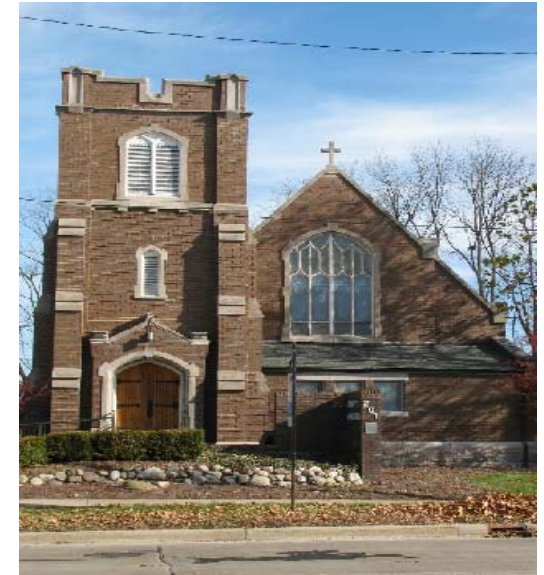
